# Remembering Pat Tillman

## Celebrating 20 years of Pat's Run

Pat Tillman was a scholar-athlete who led the Sun Devils to the 1997 Rose Bowl, graduated summa cum laude from the W. P. Carey School of Business, then was drafted by the Arizona Cardinals. On the field, he was known for his intensity as a linebacker and safety.

Off it, he relished physical challenges. He was well-read, curious, irreverent and stubborn.

On April 22, 2004, Tillman was killed in Afghanistan. The news shocked his loved ones and the country as a whole and galvanized his friends to create a run that's growing stronger 20 years later and supports the charitable foundation in his name, the Pat Tillman Foundation.

A few months after Tillman's funeral, a small group of Tillman's friends — including Garwood, Perry Edinger, Doug Tammaro, Mark Zimmer and Christina Hundley, '98 BA in journalism — gathered to figure out a way to honor Tillman.

The group set themselves a daunting task: Create an event to honor their boundary-pushing, full-of-life friend who had also become an American hero.

They settled on a run — with some twists.

The length would be 4.2 miles, in tribute to Tillman's ASU jersey number. Their vision? That the run would not finish on a road or in a parking lot, but at the 42-yard line in the stadium on the ASU Tempe campus.

"This event would not happen without ASU and the city of Tempe," Hundley says. "I mean, a race is a race, right? But the fact that we had that buy-in ... it's on ASU turf, and the locale is part of the fabric of the event."

Pat's Run launched in 2005 with 5,000 participants. Today, more than 30,000 people across all walks of life participate, in Arizona as well as in Tillman Honor Runs around the world.



**This season, the greater Sun Devil family wants to remember and honor former Sun Devil Marching Band Director Dr. Robert “Coach” Fleming.**

Coach, as he was affectionately called, served as the Associate Director of Bands and Marching Band Director for ASU from 1974-2002. He found true joy in making and teaching music, entertaining crowds and creating a band family within the Sun Devil Marching Band.

After retirement Coach was chosen to be the Conductor of the Coastal Communities Concert Band in San Diego from 2008-2013. His time with this group is something he treasured and upon his departure as the conductor he became their Conductor Emeritus.

Over the course of his career, Coach was one of the first 10 schools to receive the Sudler trophy in 1991. The award is presented to the marching band that is considered to be the best program in the country. Other personal awards and milestones Coach attained:

**1981** Selection to the American Bandmasters Association

**1984** Director of the Olympic Band

**1993** Bohumil Makovsky Memorial Award for the Outstanding College Band Director

**1996** O.M. Hatsell Excellence in Teaching Award from the AZ Music Educators Association

**2001** Distinguished Service to Music Medal Kappa Kappa Psi

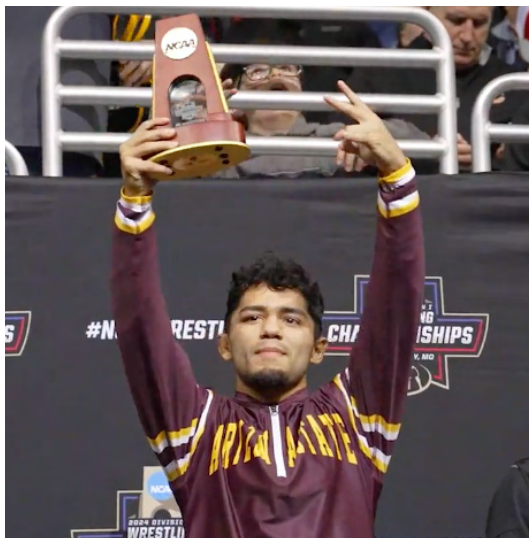
# Sun Devil Wrestling is back!

**The Sun Devils are ready to start their highly anticipated 2024-25 season, their first in the vaunted Big 12 Conference and the 11th of the Zeke Jones era.**

Defending national champion Richard Figueroa returns, seeking to become just the fourth in team history to win a second NCAA title, and Cohlton Schultz is aiming for a program-best fifth All-American honor.

Under Jones, the Sun Devils have established themselves as one of the nation's premier programs.

Five of the team's eight NCAA qualifiers from last season are back in addition to eight talented newcomers.

## Get to Know Coach Dillingham

Now in his second year, Sun Devil head coach Kenny Dillingham, at age 34, is the youngest head coach in Football Bowl Subdivision (FBS). He's also the first Arizona State alum to be named head coach of the football program.

Throughout his coaching tenure, the Scottsdale native has coached four NFL draft picks, an All-American and 11 All-Conference Selections prior to joining ASU. He has been a part of six bowl games, two with the Sun Devils as an offensive assistant.

Dillingham returned to Tempe after building his resume with a track record of impressive tenures at Memphis, Auburn, Florida State and most recently as the offensive coordinator at the University of Oregon. At Oregon, he was a nominee for the 2022 Broyles Award, presented annually to the top assistant coach in college football.

Under Dillingham's guidance, Oregon quarterback Bo Nix heard his name in Heisman Trophy conversations across the season.

As an offensive assistant in 2014, Coach Dillingham was a part of a prolific offense that ranked 13th in the nation with 5,750 total yards and 34 touchdowns.

Dillingham is considered a brilliant offensive mind, and success has followed him wherever he has gone.

In 2018, he helped the Memphis Tigers rank 4th in the nation in total offense. His offense racked up 7,324 total yards, including 3,919 rushing yards.

The following year, in 2019, he helped the Tigers to a 9-3 record and an Outback Bowl appearance and win against football powerhouse No. 5 Alabama.

# Game Day Information

## Mountain America Stadium

### Banners/Signs

Banners and signs cannot be hung over any existing signage, block the view of another guest, or contain any advertisements or profanities. Poles of any kind or size are not allowed in Mountain America Stadium.

### Cameras/Photography

Fans are welcome to bring personal cameras less than 6" and do not have a detachable lens into Mountain America Stadium. However, flash photography, monopods, tripods, and selfie sticks are not permitted in the stadium. Professional photography/cameras are not allowed in the stadium without a media credential.

### Concessions

Multiple concession stands are located on all levels throughout Mountain America Stadium. All stands offer a variety of food and beverage items. Some of the specialty concessions offered for the season include Chick-fil-A, Cold Beers & Cheeseburgers, Kona Ice, Someburros, 505 Southwestern Nacho Cantina and Venezia's Pizza.

### Elevators

Elevator access is limited throughout Mountain America Stadium. Individuals with specific needs for elevator access to seating areas should contact Guest Relations for more information at (480) 965-3933.

### First Aid

The AMR First Aid Stations are staffed by registered nurses and physicians and are located behind the south end zone, the northwest corner of the main concourse (behind section 12), the southwest end of the upper deck (behind section 201), and on the east side. Paramedics are available during all football games and regularly patrol the stadium.

### Guest Assistance Center

There are Guest Assistance Centers located inside Mountain America Stadium. They are located just inside the Southwest Gate and on the main concourse level and upper deck on the west and east sides. Guest relations representatives are available to assist with directions, seating issues, and any other questions or comments you may have.

### Lost Children

Parents of lost children should contact the nearest game management staff member, including ushers and security, regarding their lost child. They may also go to the Mountain America Stadium Police Station located behind Section 12 on the concourse level for assistance or text SPARKY 69050. Please include your location (seat/section number) and issue (lost child).

### Lost and Found

Mountain America Stadium provides lost and found services for its guests located at the Police Station behind Section 12 on the concourse. Found items should be taken to this location or given to a game day staff member. Lost and found items will be logged and kept for two weeks. Unclaimed items will be donated to charity after the two-week holding period. To check on or claim a lost and found item following football games, please call (480) 965-3933.

### Police

The Mountain America Stadium Police Station is located on the concourse behind Section 12.

### Prohibited Items

For the safety and security of our guests, all prohibited items must be returned to the owner's vehicle or discarded prior to entry. The following items are prohibited inside Mountain America Stadium and are causes for removal. No refunds:

- Soft or hard sided coolers, ice chests
- Glass or metal containers
- Outside beverages
- Tortillas
- Balloons
- Use of tobacco products, including e-cigarettes and smokeless cigarettes/tobacco
- Cameras with detachable lenses greater than 6" or video cameras

### Re-entry

Re-entry will no longer be allowed at Mountain America Stadium as the safety of our fans is the number one priority of Sun Devil Athletics, a policy commonly enforced throughout the collegiate and professional sports and entertainment landscape.

### Restrooms

There are restrooms located throughout Mountain America Stadium. Baby changing tables are available in men's and women's restrooms throughout the stadium. There are family

restrooms located throughout the stadium on the main concourse and behind sections 5, 9, and 17.

### Smoking

On August 1, 2013, ASU joined more than 800 universities and colleges nationwide in becoming a tobacco-free campus. Tobacco products are not permitted in Mountain America Stadium, including e-cigarettes and smokeless cigarettes/tobacco. ## Super Bowl Sun Devils

The Sun Devils have had some great history with the Super Bowl.

Arizona State All-American Terrell Suggs was a part of the Kansas City Chiefs Super Bowl LIV in February of 2020, giving him a pair of NFL titles after previously earning a Super Bowl ring with the Baltimore Ravens back in 2013.

With Suggs helping lead Kansas City to a victory on the biggest stage in professional sports, the Chiefs became the 32nd Super Bowl-winning team to feature a Sun Devil. An incredible 34 Super Bowl rings have been earned by Sun Devils, two of them on the hand of Terrell Suggs. Suggs becomes just the sixth Sun Devil in history to win two or more Super Bowls, joining elite company: Darren Woodson (1993, 1994, & 1995 Cowboys), Mike Richardson (1986 Bears, 1990 49ers), Jim Jeffcoat (1993 & 1994 Cowboys), Grey Ruggamer (2002 Patriots, 2008 Giants), and Marvel Smith (2006 & 2009 Steelers).

# History and traditions



## This is Sun Devil Football

### Territorial Cup®

Thanks to a historic find in a church basement several years ago, Arizona State University and the University of Arizona can now claim the oldest intercollegiate rivalry trophy in the nation. The Territorial Championship Cup®, which has been registered with the NCAA, was first presented to Tempe Normal School (now ASU) on Nov. 30, 1899, following an 11-2 victory over the University of Arizona at Tucson's Carillo Gardens Field. The Territorial Cup® was lost for a time and was discovered years ago in the basement of a church that was being demolished. According to the NCAA, the previous oldest trophy was the Michigan/Minnesota Little Brown Jug which dates back to 1909.

### The Mascot

On Nov. 8, 1946, the students of Arizona State College voted 816 to 196 in favor of changing the school's nickname from the Bulldogs

to the Sun Devils. Phoenix attorney Walter E. Craig contacted a former classmate, Berk Anthony, who was an artist employed by Walt Disney Studios. Anthony designed the Sun Devil free of charge.

### The Gear

Since July 2015, Sun Devil Athletics has partnered with adidas with a goal of advancing the brand, including the use of iconic logos like the Pitchfork as well as historic logos like Sparky and the interlocking AS. The partnership with adidas set the standard for apparel contracts by creating provisions to adapt for the addition of sports and dollars allocated towards marketing and facility upgrades. The company has also shown its investment in Sun Devil student-athletes, giving them the opportunity to test and provide feedback on its latest performance gear prior to release.

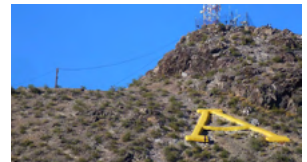

Mountain America Stadium – the only college football stadium located between two mountains. Just to the west of Mountain America Stadium is "A" Mountain. Originally installed on Tempe Butte in 1918, the letter has been changed from a "T" to an "N" to the "A" of today as the name of the school has changed. In



1952, a bomb destroyed the letter, but in 1955, the present "A", which stands 60 feet tall, was built using reinforced steel and poured concrete.

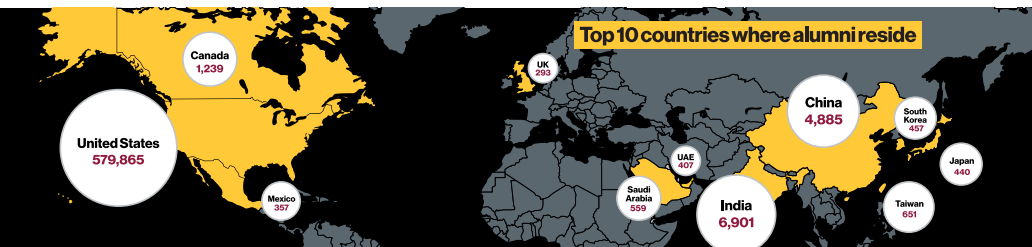
