While serving as a student host, you are required to act in accordance with NCAA, Pac-12, and Arizona State University rules and regulations, as well as state and federal law. If you do not abide by these rules and regulations, as summarized in the guidelines below, you may be subject to disciplinary measures including dismissal from your team.

- You must be enrolled as a full-time student unless otherwise permitted under NCAA rules.
- You may be provided a maximum of \$40 per day to cover the entertainment expenses for you, the PSA, and his/her parents, legal guardians, or spouse. Other student-athletes may assist with hosting the PSA, but only you may receive expense money. You may be provided an additional \$20 per day for each additional PSA you are entertaining. Entertainment money may not be used to purchase gifts or souvenirs for the PSA.
- You may not provide the PSA or anyone accompanying him/her with gifts (e.g., souvenirs, T-shirt, hat, etc.).
- You may not provide cash to the PSA or anyone else accompanying him/her.
- You may not use or provide alcohol or illegal substances to the PSA.
- You may not entertain the PSA by attending a gentleman's club (or equivalent) or by providing strippers.
- You may not use sex as a means to recruit the PSA to attend ASU.
- You and the PSA may not engage in any gambling or gaming activities.
- You may not use a coach's car or any other institutional vehicle to provide transportation to the PSA.
- You may not transport the PSA or anyone accompanying him/her more than 30 miles from ASU.
- You may not allow the PSA to use your automobile at any time.
- You must not allow recruiting conversations to occur on or off campus between the PSA and any representative of ASU's athletics interests (e.g., booster, alumnus, former student-athlete). If an unplanned meeting occurs, no more than an exchange of a greeting (e.g., hello) is permissible.
- You may receive a complimentary admission when accompanying a PSA to an ASU athletics event.
- You may receive a complimentary meal when attending a meal provided by ASU as part of the PSA's official visit.
